## LCRT Shares 100% Design Milestone with Community

Lowcountry Rapid Transit (LCRT) reached a major milestone with the completion of 100% design earlier this year.

To mark this achievement, the Berkeley-Charleston-Dorchester Council of Governments (BCDCOG) hosted a series of community engagement events in coordination with other regional transit initiatives. At these events, the project team shared design details and project updates with community members and stakeholders from across the region.
