In 2023, the project team:



Completed 30% design plans and progressed into the development of 60% design plans



Celebrated LCRT's inclusion in the advancement and funding recommendation for 18 major transit projects across the U.S. as part of President Biden's FY 2024 Budget



Engaged with communities, businesses, and stakeholders from across the region through key involvement opportunities and public and neighborhood meetings



Hosted four transit oriented development workshops where over 100 community members gave input on equitable development around LCRT station areas



Relocated three LCRT stations to better reflect community needs and align with other local projects
