Engagement Highlights

In 2021, the team organized **795 outreach events** and talked to countless individuals about LCRT. These events included community office hours, one-on-one meetings with businesses and community events along the LCRT corridor. These types of engagements help involve and inform the community, while also building excitement for the project's future.

The project team also held a virtual public meeting in the spring that had more than **3,000 individuals** participate.
