- Standardize station architecture and layouts for different areas of the corridor
- Determine details of traffic signal priority



Prepare for construction of the project

- Determine phasing considerations
- Outline contract specifications
- Determine plans for construction alongside traffic



Coordinate and collaborate

- Collaborate with utilities, railroads, and other entities within the project footprint

Over the next two years, we will:

- Complete the right-of-way (ROW) process
- Continue engaging with stakeholders, project partners, and the public
- Secure full FTA grant funding
- Advertise and award the project's construction contract
- Begin construction

The project team has held over 1,500 touchpoints with stakeholders and the community since the project's initiation. The community and stakeholders' feedback and input has been invaluable to developing the system and will continue to be utilized as we work to refine its final design.

We maintain our commitment to collaboration with agencies, municipalities, and stakeholders as the project moves forward and look forward to continuing work toward construction in the coming years.
