

# PROJECT UPDATE As of July 1, 2024

#### LCRT Approaches 60% Design Milestone

Over the last two years, our project team has been hard at work advancing LCRT through the Engineering phase and incorporating feedback received from project partners, stakeholders, and community members to progress from 30% to 60% design.

The upcoming 60% design plans will include **refinements to the project's footprint**, **expansion of design details**, and **updates to the cost estimate**. As part of this process, the engineering team has evaluated numerous factors and engaged in various activities that will inform the project's final design and further coordination efforts.



## Refinements to the project's footprint includes...

- Establishing potential construction limits in alignment with LCRT's purpose and need
- Extensive coordination with corridor-adjacent projects to eliminate duplicative efforts
- Detailed technical surveying and reporting to help inform the overall design



## Expansion of design details includes...

- Branding, design, and engineering details to inform station construction
- Additional pavement details for sidewalks, shared use paths, bus lanes, and roadways
- Intersection and signal details to advance system efficiency and reliability



## Updates to the cost estimate includes...

- Project reviews to keep an on-budget project and account for any changes in costs, labor, and materials
- Preparation for ridership, cost, and schedule projections in advance of future FTA grant funding awards

As we close in on 60% design completion this summer, our team looks forward to engaging with communities, stakeholders, and the public to present and review these design plans this fall. We remain committed to delivering on the promise that brings high quality, affordable, and accessible bus rapid transit to our region.
