LCRT is making progress toward breaking ground on South Carolina's first bus rapid transit system.

## **Continuing to Reach Milestones**

Last month, we announced that the project had reached three major milestones to move it closer to bringing world-class bus rapid transit to our region. This month, we're sharing updates that coincide with those milestones.



National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) documentation has been completed and signed by FTA.

We're continuing to share this news with our stakeholders, and this document is now publicly available on our website for further review.



30% design plans are complete.

These plans are also available online for review; we are continuing our outreach efforts to on-corridor businesses and neighborhoods to present and review these corridor plans.



Initial readiness documents have been submitted to FTA for inclusion in the President's Annual Report.
