Lowcountry Rapid Transit is a 21.5-mile modern bus rapid transit project that will connect the communities of Charleston, North Charleston and Ladson. More than just a transit system, this project will transform the infrastructure in our region to improve mobility for people on public transit, in cars, on foot and on bikes.

The Lowcountry Rapid Transit project team invites you to a virtual public meeting, where we provide a project update, summarize the work we've accomplished to date and outline our next steps as we continue Phase 2 of the project.

What We've Been Working On

Since our last public meeting in June 2020, the Berkeley-Charleston-Dorchester Council of Governments, LCRT's sponsor agency, has taken exciting steps to advance the project. Through public and stakeholder input, environmental and ridership analyses and early steps in the transit orientated development study, we have:



Refined the system route and station locations



Designed roadway, station and bus features



Advanced our Transit Oriented Development (TOD) planning strategy to focus on livable, walkable communities centered around public transit stations
