What is Bus Rapid Transit?

Bus rapid transit (BRT) is a high-quality transit system that delivers fast, comfortable, and cost-effective services, operating predominantly in dedicated lanes throughout key areas of the corridor, keeping cars and the BRT system separate. Technology such as off-board payment and transit signal priority allow travel times to be consistent and reliable throughout the corridor.

The LCRT Route

The route begins in Ladson and travels along US 78 into North Charleston. From there, LCRT will travel along US 52/Rivers Avenue and into Downtown Charleston by way of King Street Extension. The route continues down Meeting Street, along Calhoun Street into the Medical District and to the WestEdge Development. Here, LCRT will loop to return to Ladson along the same route.

This route will connect the region, its communities, key destinations, and employment centers.
