Spring 2021 Virtual Public Meeting Summary

More than 3,000 individuals participated in the Lowcountry Rapid Transit (LCRT) virtual public meeting that ran from April 26-May 26, 2021. The public was invited to take an in-depth look at opportunities and enhancements that LCRT can bring to the region. The average visit to the meeting was 7.5 minutes for the public to view the corridor visualization, explore the interactive map, and view the proposed station designs.

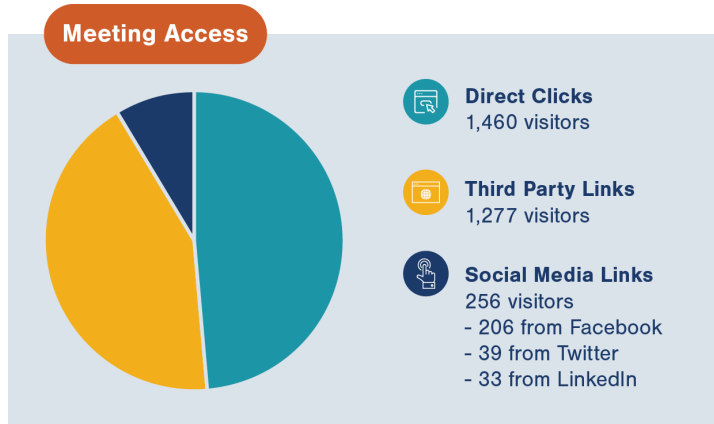
